Operation Sacristy	High	£0	£1,440k	Costs to end of October are £754k with expected costs for 2011/12 of £1.440m. The mitigation proposal around this is for the costs to be funded from reserves, therefore not impacting the outturn on the budget delegated to the Chief Constable - this will be brought for Members approval at a later date.
Redeployment Pool	Low	£0	£450k	The underspend position is based on the current forecast for the redeployment pool level for the remainder of the year. Should that forecast deviate and the Force have to pay Steria for their full contractual liability, the half-year effect would be c. £450k.
Insurance	Medium	£858k	£300k	Insurance has been an area of pressure for the last two years and it causing concern again in 2011/12. This will be closely monitored for the remainder of the financial year. This pressure is built into the current forecast. Full analysis and review has been requested of the insurance companies.
